AUSTRALIAN ICON IAN MOSS TOURS WITH WES CARR at Kedron-Wavell Services Club Friday 11th December 2009!

5-time ARIA Award winner, Ian Moss, heads to your local Club - Kedron-Wavell Services Club, 375 Hamilton Rd, Chermside on Friday 11th December 2009 complete with a three piece acoustic band with special guest Wes Carr as support.

Ian Moss is respected as one of Australia's iconic musicians, and delivers an unforgettable sound – not only as a telling soloist on guitar but especially with his silken voice, ringing with clarity and resonating with pure soul. Whole primarily recognised as an axeman of unusual tenacity and sweet melodic sensibility, Ian's distinctive vocal is the essential signature of his soulful, bluesy muse – as it has been since his first tentative foray into music during the early 1970s.

As a member of one of the most successful Australian bands of all time, Cold Chisel, and widely accepted as Australia's best guitarist, Moss carefully evolved into a solo artist of the same calibre. Ian has recorded 5 solo albums; from his ARIA #1 debut effort Matchhook, featuring hit singles Tucker's Daughter and Telephone Booth, to the raw bluesy rock of Petrolhead, to the acoustic Six Strings and Let's All Get Together albums. Whenever he went back out on the road, Moss's live shows drew a hoard of Chisel faithful and a league of new fans and showed him to be an especially dextrous musical stylist; not just a rock player, not just an acoustic strummer, but a truly seasoned and rounded musical talent.

Heading back out on the road, Moss has invited singer/songwriter Wes Carr to join him as a special guest. Australian Idol winner Wes can be described as many things – overnight success, is not one of them. Born and raised in Adelaide, Carr first began to teach himself guitar and piano at the age of twelve. As his school years began to leave him uninspired, Wes moved to Sydney and won a scholarship to a performing arts school and started playing his own local gigs. Wes received widespread acclaim when he collaborated with Ben Gilles from Silverchair under the moniker of Tambalance. Carr's debut post-idol single You hit the #1 spot on the ARIA charts in late 2008 and his major label debut album The Way the World Looks has achieved Gold Sales.

Ian will perform tracks from Soul on West 53rd as well as a selection of his Moss/Chisel classis and to round off the performance will invite Wes on stage for what is bound to be a show stopping encore. The authenticity of both Ian and Wes as performers is at the heart of the connection they have with audiences around Australia; with their approachable demeanour, love of music, and sheer talent combined, audiences are guaranteed to be part of something special.
